Exchange Legislation Landscape

- States need authorizing language to set up Health Benefit Exchanges
- Multiple contentious issues:
 - Whether or not to have an Exchange?
 - Governance (most are going with quasigovernmental)
 - Who serves on the Board?
 - Advisory councils and other public input?
 - Conflict of interest provisions
 - Procurement, hiring, compensation, meeting rules





Exchange Legislation Landscape

- States are also working to get input and buyin from the public and multiple stakeholders
 - Committees, working groups, public hearings
- Health reform leadership and management:
 - Coordinating councils
 - Designated staff
 - Need to transfer decision-making to a new entity once Exchange is created
